


















Communication, Language & Literacy

Discussion Texts

There will be a continuation of weekly Spelling Punctuation and Grammar (SPAG) lessons on Monday's, Vocabulary relating to discussion texts on Tuesday's, Modelling/Planning on Wednesday's, Independent practice on Thursday's and Oracy lessons on Friday's. Students will also improve their phonics skills working on the relevant books they are on.

Science

How are rocks formed and what are the different types?

Children look at the Rock Cycle to help understand where and how rocks are formed. Students will look at the different features of the rocks to help identify sedimentary and igneous rocks and their characteristics.



Geography – Weather and Climate

What is the topographical landscape like in the Uk?

Using their existing knowledge of Rivers, Mountains, Volcanoes and Valleys, children will explore what these features are like in the UK and where and how to find these. Further exploration of how they change will also take place.
