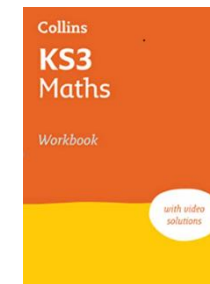
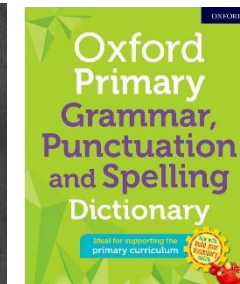
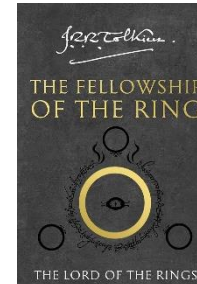
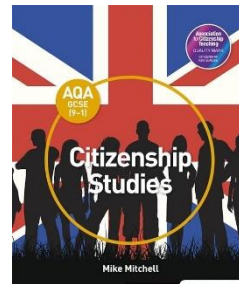
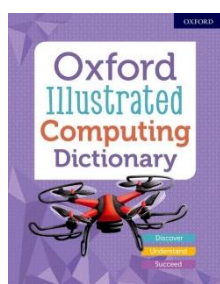
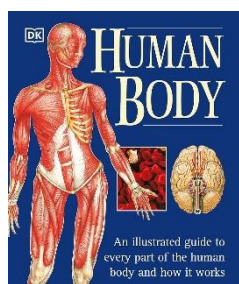
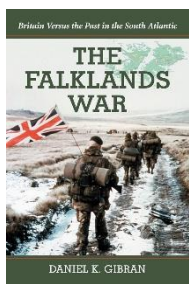


**Class: Antlers**

**Books to support our learning.**



### **Communication, Language & Literacy**

This term we are focusing on the tale of The Lord of Rings Fellowship of the Ring. Focusing on Authors studies, world building, quote analysis, its wider impact on society, the films and the fantasy genre. We will continue to focus on Spelling, Punctuation and Grammar as well as focusing on comprehension and guided reading.



### **Numeracy & Problem Solving**

In this unit students focus on place value. Focusing on place value in variety of topics including: integers, decimals, metric and imperial units, ordering and comparing numbers and problem solving activities.

### **Science**

#### **Human Machine**

The learner will identify how skin temperature changes, how vision can be affected, look at insulating properties, carry out surveys, describe changes to fertility rates in different countries over time and carry out coordination tests.

### **PSHE**

#### **Celebrating Difference**

This term we will be answering the questions: Equality: what does it mean to me in the UK? What does equality in the workplace mean? What are the benefits of being in a multicultural society? Why is it important to challenge inequality.

#### **My Place**

This term we will be looking at where we come from. Completing PowerPoints on our favourite places, looking at census data, creating tour guides of our local area, completing surveys and researching local issues that affect us and our community.

### **Citizenship**

#### **Rights and Responsibilities**

Your child will take part in a variety of discussions and tasks involving Human Rights, Global Citizenship, how responsibilities change over time, research important figures in the history of human rights as well as understanding our rights as consumers and employees.

### **Computing**

The learner will develop their understanding of computer systems, the uses of hardware and software, the advantages and disadvantages of different devices.

### **DofE**

In DofE this year our class will be focusing on their Silver/Gold award. This involves an expedition; volunteering, giving their time to benefit others; skills, developing an interest or hobby that they have; physical, working on improving their health and fitness.
