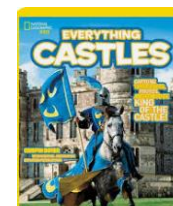
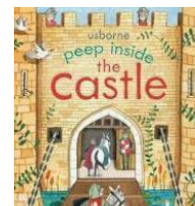
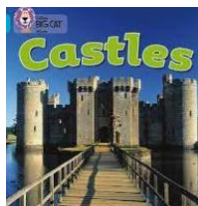
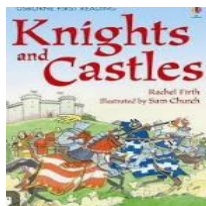
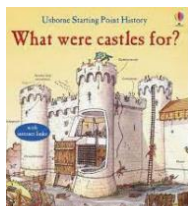


Books to support our learning.



Communication, Language & Literacy

This half term our RWI phonic groups will continue to take part in speed sound lessons which will develop their phonic awareness. They will be reading phonics books linked to their reading level. Our beyond groups will be reading a range of non-fiction texts. They shall be identifying features of a non-fiction texts e.g instructions and attempting to use these features when writing their own instructions. We shall also continue to work within our guided reading groups to develop our comprehension skills.

Numeracy & Problem Solving

In Maths we shall be continuing to follow the white rose maths programme. We will be learning about money by making amounts, comparing amounts and solving a range of problems involving money. Later in the term we shall also be learning about multiplication. We will be making groups and using arrays to solve multiplication problems.

Computing

This half term we will be exploring how to create documents by modifying text, images, and page layouts. We will answer the question how can I edit my document?

Science

In science this half term we shall be exploring everyday materials. We shall be naming, grouping and sorting materials such as glass, wood, metal, paper and fabric. We shall explore which material is best suited for a given task through predicting and experimenting. This half term we will be answering the question, Which material will be best to use for a roof for our castle?

Knowledge and Understanding of the World

This half term we will be developing our historical and geographical knowledge through learning about Bamburgh Castle. We will look at the features of castles before learning about how and when Bamburgh Castle was built and having a visit to the castle itself. We shall be answering the question, What is special about Bamburgh Castle? In Religious Education we shall be learning about belonging and exploring what groups we belong to. We will be answering the question, What does it mean to belong to a faith community?

The Arts

In art this half term we will be working on creating 3D models by designing and creating our own Knight helmets and swords linked to our castles topic. . We will answer the question how do I create a 3D piece of art? In Design and Technology our focus will be sculpture. We shall be exploring a range of materials and selecting which materials will be best to create our own castle. We shall be answering the question which materials do I need to build my castle?

Enrichment & Ways to Wellbeing

During PSHE lessons this half term we will be focusing on healthy eating. We will be discussing the different food groups and exploring what a healthy and balanced diet consists of. We shall also explore why it is important we eat a healthy diet. We shall also be making and tasting a range of healthy foods and meals. We will be answering the question, How can I make sure I am eating a healthy diet?

Therapeutic Input

As well as input from physio and SALT teams this half term we shall be continuing to look at ways to support self regulation. We shall be taking part in the daily mile and mindful colouring activities to support self regulation.

Physical Education

In PE this half term we shall be continuing to follow our Get Set PE scheme through completing our tennis topic. We will also continue to swim every week.
