Communication, Language & Literacy

LC- Independently write a basic sentence using appropriate grammar.

We will be learning how to format and write a basic sentence for a variety of purposes. We will be learning how to identify capital letters and full stops in text and how to use appropriately in our own writing.

Phonics – In daily phonics sessions we will develop our knowledge of general sounds, spelling, writing and ability to decode and segment words.

Science
