## Curriculum Expectations

### Intent

History aims to develop historical skills and concepts which are transferable to whatever period of history is being studied and will equip children for future learning. These key historical skills and concepts, which are revisited throughout different units, are: Historical Interpretations; Historical Investigations; Chronological Understanding; Knowledge and Understanding of Events, People and Changes in the Past; Presenting, Organising and Communicating.

History will be taught through engaging, motivating and progressive units across the school. History lessons will:

- ❖ start with an engagement/thought provoking stimulus
- ❖ share a 'Big Learning Question'
- ❖ allow pupils to become confident with subject vocabulary

- ❖ Enrich the curriculum with visits and cross curricular learning
