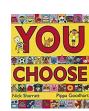

Our Class Reads

Physical Development

This half-term we will focus on moving in different ways as we learn about our bodies. We will look at how we can control our bodies to make different shapes and how we can move safely around the environment. Our weekly swimming lessons will be used to develop our water safety, building our water confidence and strengthening our muscles. We will also be working on our own individual targets.

Literacy

This half-term we will be focussing on comprehension through working on rhymes as well as our individual literacy targets. These include identifying and discriminating sounds, learning the Set 1 phonics sounds (x,z,qu,sh,th,ch) and beginning to learn the skills needed to blend these sounds.

Expressive Arts and Design

This half-term we will experiment with sounds. We will explore different sounds we can make with our bodies and different instruments, as well as listening to different sounds in our environment. Our artwork will focus around ourselves. We will continue to enjoy a range of our favourite songs and rhymes in daily songtime.



Super Me

Communication and Language

Communication is at the heart of everything we do in Ladybird class. We will be working on building our communication skills and understanding of language through spoken words, Makaton and PECS. As well as being incorporated into everything we do, we will work on our individual targets through small group activities and 1:1 work with an adult.

Therapeutic Input

We will be working closely with the Speech and Language Therapist, Physiotherapist, Occupational Therapists and Multi-sensory teacher to work on our individual targets.

Personal, Social and Emotional Development

This term we will be focusing on Building Relationships. This half-term we will be learning to develop our self-confidence through trying new activities and sharing these with our friends. We will also be working on our own individual targets and continue to build independence in personal care and regulating our emotions.

Mathematics

This half-term our numeracy work will focus on more or less. We will be working on individual targets to develop our understanding of basic mathematical principles and numeracy skills, such as counting and 1:1 correspondence. We will also develop our understanding of measure through a focus on heights.

Understanding the World

Through our topic work on All About Me, this half-term we will be focussing on what makes each of us unique and where we belong. We will look at features of our bodies, things that we like and people who are special to us. We will learn about similarities and differences between people and groups. We will also look at the seasonal effects of Spring.
