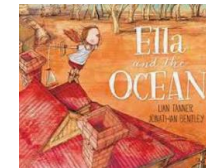
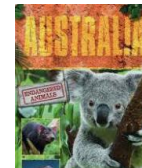
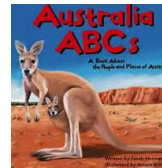
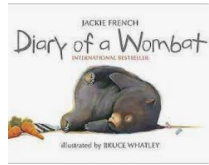


Books to support our learning.



Communication, Language & Literacy

This half term our RWI phonic groups will continue to take part in daily speed sound lessons which will develop their phonic awareness. They shall be reading and working on texts linked to their reading level. Our beyond groups will learning to identify the features of instructions and recounts. They shall then use this knowledge to be write their own instructions and recounts.

Science

Our topic in science this half term is plants. During this half term we shall learn the names of parts of a plant and identify each parts role in helping the plant survive. We will be carrying out investigations and experiments into what plants need to grow well. Children will also closely observe the inside of a seed and learn about the life cycle of a plant. They will also learn how plants look when they don't get the things they need. We shall also learn how plants have adapted to live in different environments around the world.

This half term we will be answering the question,
How can I help a plant to grow well?

Enrichment & Ways to Wellbeing

During PSHE lessons this half term we are excited to be following out new Jigsaw PSHE scheme. This half terms focus is healthy me. The children will learn what their body needs to stay healthy as well as how to stay safe through road safety and medicine safety lessons. We will be answering the question, **Why is it important to stay healthy?**



Knowledge and Understanding of the World

This half term we will be developing our geographical knowledge by learning about Australia. We will use maps to discover where Australia is. We will also learn about the climate in Australia and some of its famous landmarks. We shall also compare Australia to the United Kingdom. We shall be answering the question, **What is life like in Australia?**

In Religious Education we shall be continuing to explore Christianity. We will be answering the question, **What is the "good news" Christians believe Jesus brought?**

Therapeutic Input

As well as input from our SALT team this half term we shall be looking at ways to self regulate. We shall be using theraputty and mindful colouring to help us relax.

Numeracy & Problem Solving

In Maths this half term we will be focusing on money. We shall be learning to recognise and sort coins and notes. We shall then use our additions and subtraction skills to count amounts, make amounts and give change. The children will then solve a range problem solving and reasoning skills linked to money.

Computing

This half term we shall be using a range of programmes to edit our photographs. We shall answer the question,
How can I improve my photograph through editing?

The Arts

In art this half term we shall be working with fabrics to create our own textile art. We shall create our own fabric pictures and flags through cutting, gluing and stitching **Which fabric is best to use in my art?** In Design and Technology we will designing and making 3D landmarks as part of our geography topic. We shall be answering the question **Which material is best to use to build our landmark?** In music we shall be learning about how pitch and tempo effect the mood of the music.

Physical Education

In PE this half term we shall be learning to play table tennis games. We shall also continue to take part in our weekly swimming sessions.
