




Communication, Language & Literacy

In English, we will be learning about different types of poetry.

This will include poems relating to: Bonfire night,
Remembrance Day and Christmas. Through reading and
listening to these poems, students will explore the techniques
and learn how they can be implemented for greater effect.

This will then be put in practice to describe the poems
meanings and story.

Science

How are light and sound different from each other?

In Science, we will be learning about the difference between light and sound. Discovery of how light travels will take place and how to group light sources to identify them clearer. Students will learn about how sound travels and how to identify different pitches.

PSHE, Enrichment & Ways to Wellbeing

What are the differences between others?

In our PSHE lessons, we will be exploring differences in others and why this should be celebrated and acknowledged. We will look at why bullying exists and how to overcome potential obstacles.

Therapeutic Input

Those who receive input from SaLT and Thrive will continue to do so. We will have regular sensory breaks between lessons this half term with our sensory station being implemented.



Stone age to Iron age

Humanities

What was it like in the Stone age?

This half term we will be focusing on learning about the Iron age and how it led to the Stone age era. There will be a discovery of how societies used to be and have evolved over time. We will be exploring consequences of things happening and their impact on today's world.

Numeracy & Problem Solving

This half term, students will focus on addition and subtraction and consolidating existing knowledge. This will be done through games-based learning as well as through White Rose maths. Students will be able to work with numbers of varying sizes to build on their place value knowledge.

Computing

How can I use variables accurately in coding?

Students will be learning about coding programmes and how they can be manipulated using strings and variables. There will be an opportunity to create their own game and change the finer details using their coding skills.

Art

How can you create light and dark?

This half term students will be looking at how to create light and dark in drawings and how this can affect specific drawings.

Students will also experiment with different colours and mix them together to create their artwork.

Physical Education

What are the gymnastic techniques needed to improve my flexibility?

There will be a focus on gymnastics this half term, so students can learn the correct techniques and how to perform them safely. There will be a focus on co-ordination, balance and flexibility.
