


Term: Spring 1

Communication, Language & Literacy

This term, we will continue with our Read, Write Inc. and other carefully chosen texts to improve in our Reading journey. We will focus on reading between the lines with inference and question what the author wants us to think.

We will start reading for pleasure the class novel of Shadow Forest by Matt Haig.

Science

What colour is a Polar Bear's skin?

In Science, we will investigate how living things have changed over time to suit the environment that they live in and that this adaptation may lead to evolution. We will give reasons why we think those living things had to evolve.

We will be using Stormbreak activities to help us establish the importance of movement and being happy. We will take daily Stormbreaks activities with Andy and be able to explain how they make us feel.



TRADE and ECONOMICS

Knowledge and Understanding of the World

What is Fair Trade and why is important.

Over the coming weeks we will look into what Trade is and how the world benefits from it. We will research into Fair Trade and why it is important that people are treated "fairly". We will visit local shops and look for Fair Trade products; are they freely available in Alnwick?

RE

Why is the Torah so important to Jewish people?

We will be looking at Judaism and the impact it has on those that follow it. We will specifically look at the Jewish holy book, the Torah, and its importance to the faith.

Numeracy & Problem Solving

This half term, our focus in Numeracy will be Multiplication and Division. We will be looking at strategies to help us use our times tables effectively including times table squares and counting sticks. We will use problem-solving skills to help us with reasoning questions.

Computing
