Communication, Language & Literacy

RE

Should Christians be greener than everyone else?

In RE, we will consider and weigh up how ideas studied in this unit relate to our own experiences and experiences of the world today, developing insights of our own and giving good reasons for the views we have and the connections they make.

Physical Education

Is it easy to get fit?

In Pe, we will take part in a range of activities that explore and develop different area of health and fitness. We'll look at speed, stamina, co-ordination, balance and agility. We will need to persevere when we get tired or when we find a challenge hard. We will encourage others to do the same.

Maths & Problem Solving

In our Maths groups, our focus switches to the four operations: addition, subtraction, multiplication and division. As well as fluency, we'll look at problem-solving and reasoning questions.

Some of us will develop our arithmetic skills and learn where practically we might use these maths skills in real-life.

Computing

What do I need to know to create a game?

Using coding skills, we will learn to code a game with a timer and a score. We will learn to understand the different functions needed to create a game. We will learn to recognise code and debug (fix) code that is not delivering the required actions.

Art & Design Technology

During art with Faye, we will develop our Drawing skills using different techniques and types of lines. We will use lines to create different patterns.

In DT, we will learn ways food is preserved and why it is preserved. We will list simple routines to help stop the spread of germs. We will prepare a range of simple food ingredients.
